HP Volunteer meetings

Name Change

The Henderson Police Department Management Team approved the name change for the volunteer program. We are officially known as the “Henderson Police Volunteers” or “HPV” for short.

The website has been changed to www.hpdv.org soon. All volunteer hours must be entered at that website. You do not have to enter hours if a sign-in sheet is used at an event.

“Every 15 Minutes”

The “Every 15 Minutes” program will be presented at Basic High School on April 8 and 9, 2010. Community Relations has asked for our assistance. The Community Relations Unit will be at our February meeting to discuss the April event.

Handicapped Parking

Three hundred and two citations were issued during 2009 by the HP Volunteer parking enforcement teams. Excellent work.

Training

Training for the HP Volunteers is being developed by the Training Bureau.

A modified Citizens Academy is being developed that will provide an overview of the Henderson Police Department for the volunteers. This will be exclusively for the HPV's and will be mandatory for all volunteers that have not attended a Citizens Academy.

A defensive driving class is planned for the volunteers that may need to drive City of Henderson vehicles. This class is to meet the requirement set by the City Risk Manager and the City Attorney.

Instructors from the Las Vegas Fire Department have agreed to conduct CERT training for the HP Volunteers. We are looking for a facility that can be used for the training.

Preliminary discussions have been held to determine the feasibility of HP Volunteers taking reports at the desk. This has been considered before, but the economy and rapidly advancing technology, makes our taking reports a possibility.

Employee Open Indoor Cycling

Henderson Police Volunteers wishing to take advantage of the indoor cycling opportunities at the Downtown Recreation Center may do so by obtaining a participant ID card at the Rec Center. You must present your Volunteer ID Card to sign up and use the facility. This is not open to the public.

Submitting Volunteer Hours

Hours worked **MUST** be submitted by the last day of the month they are worked. All of the volunteer hours are included to the Chief and posted on the City of Henderson computer network monthly. This information is used in the strategic planning process and needs to be timely.
