### **HP Volunteer meetings**

All HPV members are required to attend a Henderson Citizen Academy or Volunteer Academy to remain a member of the program. Since the Citizen Academy tends to fill up fast, the Training Bureau is conducting an Academy for volunteers only.

### **Community Emergency Response Training (C.E.R.T.)**

Congratulations to our members currently attending the C.E.R.T. classes at the Las Vegas Fire Training Center.

These individuals will be placed on a call-out list for C.E.R.T and will receive additional training opportunities and will be called on to participate in disaster drills throughout Clark County.

### **Civilian Driving Awareness**

Any Henderson Police Volunteer assigned to drive a City of Henderson vehicle, must complete a department-approved drivers training class. The Training Bureau will be conducting a "Civilian Driving Awareness" class on Thursday, August 12<sup>th</sup>.

The training will consist of a classroom session in the morning followed by behind the wheel training at the EVOC track.

If you have completed the Metropolitan Police Department's EVOC training within the past two years, please let me know as this may meet the City of Henderson requirement.

The July HPV meeting will be held on Monday, July 26, 2010, at the North Command Station, 225 E. Sunset Road, in the training room at 7:00 PM.

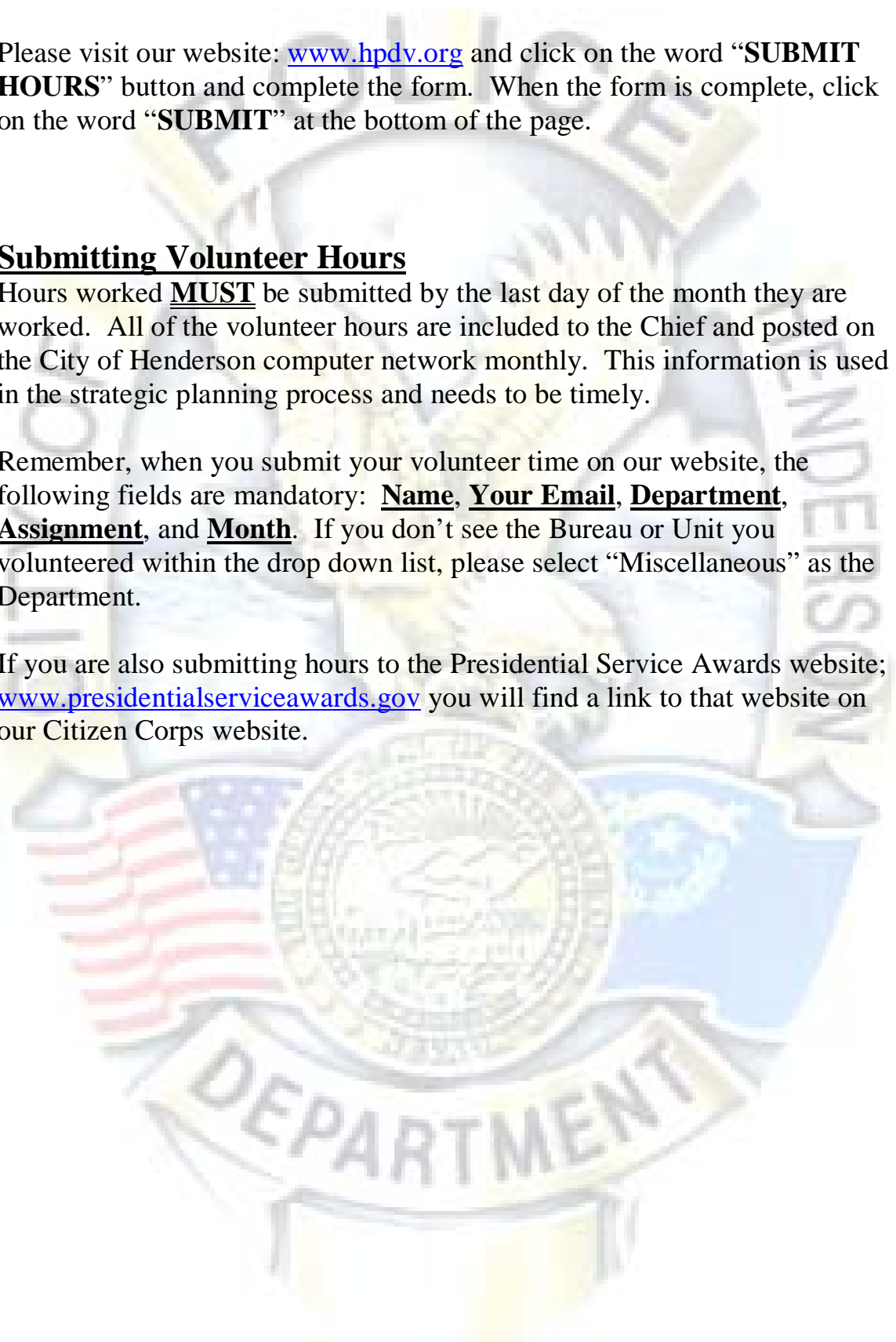
